Garbage, Recycle, & Tree Limb Services

The City of Kemah is contracted with AmeriWaste to provide Residential garbage/trash service in Kemah.

Contact City Hall at 281-334-1611 to register for service.

Contact AmeriWaste at 281-331-8400 to report service issues.



Monday & Thursday Service

On the Curb by 7:00 AM

Garbage Pickup

plus

Brush/Tree Limb Pickup

- Limit of 2 cubic yards per week.
- Must be securely tied together forming an easily handled package.
- Must not exceed five (5) feet in length, eighteen (18) inches in diameter, and no more than fifty (50) pounds in weight.

Thursday Only Heavy Trash Pickup

(Acceptable Items)

- Heavy trash is defined by the contract as
- junk or trash which is generated by ordinary maintenance of a household, but is too large for containers, items such as:
- Appliances, water heaters, furniture, mattresses, dishwashers, drained lawn mowers, and grills.
- Heavy trash items must be sorted and stacked in a manner in which they can be easily lifted onto a truck without special equipment.

If you have a large amount, you must contact AmeriWaste to schedule a pickup.

Tuesday Service On the Curb by 7:00 AM

Recycling Pickup

(Acceptable Recycling Items)

Paper & Cardboard:

- Corrugated cardboard (boxes)
- Magazines
- Office paper (all colors)
- Newspapers
- Paperboard (cereal boxes)
- Unsolicited direct mail (even window envelopes are okay)
- Phone books.

Metals:

- Aluminum cans
- Steel cans and tincans (rinsed-out soup cans, veggie cans, coffee cans, etc.)
- Wire coat hangers

Plastics:

- Typically soft drink and soda bottles
- Plastics from cereal boxes
- Containers for salad dressing, vegetable oil, butter, margarine, and peanut butter
- Oven-ready meal trays
- Containers for laundry detergent and some household cleaners.

Don't recycle it until it's clean!

Hazardous Waste

Normal Household Hazard Waste (including refrigerators, paint, TVs, microwaves, electronics, and computers) will be picked up on a quarterly on-call basis. Call Ameriwaste at 281-331-8400 to be placed on a list to be notified prior to scheduled pick up.

Construction type materials, junk cars, engines, tires, oil, or other hazardous materials will not be picked up.

City of Kemah

Brush/Tree Limb Pickup (3rd Wednesday of the month)

- Limited to an additional 2 cubic yards of tree limbs per household.
- Must not exceed 6 inches in diameter or 7.5 feet in length
- Must be placed on a flat accessible surface within 3 feet of the roadway.

The City will not provide on-call brush or debris pick up. You will need to make alternative arrangements for the disposal of large quantity items including tree removals, tree trunks, and tree stumps. This is not included in the services provided by the City of Kemah or AmeriWaste.

If the normal service day falls on a Holiday, your next pickup will be on the next regularly scheduled weekly service date of the same type.
